VICTORIAN LIONS FOUNDATION Inc.

In the 2015 Annual Report of the **National Vision Research Institute [NVRI]** Lion **Professor Michael Ibbotson** [Director NVRI] wrote that “Lions Clubs of Australia have generously supported the NVRI for many decades, and this continued in 2014. We are very grateful for the input which provides partial funds for a Lions Research Fellowship. Having watched their unstinting activities, I **decided to become a Lion myself** and enjoyed engaging with the organisation and getting involved in their many and varied fund raising activities. The importance of funding from non-Federal grant sources is increasing. In 2014 the success rate for grants from the National Health and Medical Research Council dropped to around 14% - just one in seven grants were funded.

A very pleasing scientific outcome for the year was to have published the results of a project that Dr. Shaun Cloherty [our Lions Research Fellow] and I initiated while working at New York University in 2011.”

Also in the report, Chair, NVRI Board, Professor Trichur Vidyasagar wrote “The infrastructure and intellectual support from the Melbourne University and the financial help from its donors such as the Lions Clubs.....are vital for achieving the goals of the Institute.”

The National Vision Research Institute is part of the large consortium, Bionic Vision Australia, that is developing bionic eyes and

collectively the consortium has implanted three patients with such devices, with excellent results, showing that the devices work and will become clinically important as they are refined in coming years. **Fantastic to know that our funds are being used for such important and necessary research.**
