Is the theme of the 2016–2017 Peace Poster Contest. Lions Clubs can sponsor the program in their community for children in local schools or organised youth groups.

Students who will be 11, 12 or 13 years of age on November 15th 2016 are eligible to participate. Through the contest students are encouraged to visually depict their interpretation of the contest's theme. It is also very important that the wording about the theme is what the poster is about, **not** what the child is thinking.

Lions Clubs may purchase a contest kit from Club Supplies at Newcastle Office. Artwork must be no smaller than 33cm by 50cm and no larger than 50cm by 60cm.

October 1st 2016 – Deadline to purchase kits from the Club Supplies. Posters **Must** be sent to The District Chairman.


